Michael King from the Colorado Department of Transportation provided an overview of the electric vehicle work happening across the State of Colorado. He discussed the most recent electric vehicle plan and high-level state targets for electric vehicle sales. Mr. King reviewed various funding sources to build public charging infrastructure and what state resources are available if the National Electric Vehicle Infrastructure funding goes away. Mr. King covered the importance of installing both Direct Current (DC) fast chargers as well as Level 2 chargers.

Hannah Morrison, from the Portland Bureau of Transportation, presented on electric vehicle charging in the public right-of-way. The City of Portland is working with utility companies to install pedestal or pole-mounted level two electric vehicle chargers. The chargers will have dedicated parking spaces that are exclusive to electric vehicles. This required an update to their city code to create electric vehicle-only charging spaces. Vandalism is a concern, so the chargers will be installed high up on utility poles. Utility companies interested in participating in the program must apply for a utility permit, and the city is limiting one charger per block. The city is building in reporting requirements that require data to be shared quarterly.

### **Grant opportunities:**

Mr. Joyce shared information on two grant programs that are currently accepting applications. The first is the [Community Accelerated Mobility Project \(CAMP\)](#) grant program through the Colorado Energy Office. The second is the [Regional Transportation District Partnership Program Grant program](#).

### **Partner agency updates and other matters**

Mr. Joyce asked if any participants on the call had updates. Mr. King shared that CDOT is looking for fellows and interns. Both are paid opportunities and more [information can be found online](#).
