Resolution No. 35, 2025

A resolution authorizing the Executive Director to negotiate and execute a contract with Fehr and Peers to provide conceptual design, community engagement, and financial modeling services for DRCOG's Central Area General Improvement District (CAGID) and City of Boulder Mobility Hub project in an amount not to exceed \$250,000 for a period of 16 months from the date of contract execution.

Whereas, DRCOG established the Innovative Mobility set-aside program to assist regional partners as they plan for, and prepare, innovative solutions to mobility challenges in the Denver region; and

Whereas, a total of four million dollars is available in the Innovative Mobility set-aside over the four-year period of the 2024-2027 Transportation Improvement Program; and

Whereas, the CAGID and City of Boulder Mobility Hub project was approved by the DRCOG board in December 2024 and seeks to create concept plans for converting five existing city managed parking garages into multi-functional mobility hubs.

Whereas, DRCOG conducted a competitive bidding process administered by a selection panel consisting of staff from DRCOG's Active and Emerging Mobility team, Subarea and Project Planning team, and contracting team as well as City of Boulder's Community Vitality Department; and

Whereas, the selection panel determined that Fehr and Peers submitted the best overall proposal that demonstrated their experience, capability and understanding to successfully deliver the required services.

Now, therefore, be it resolved that the Finance and Budget Committee authorizes the Executive Director to negotiate and execute a contract with Fehr and Peers to provide conceptual design, community engagement, and financial modeling services for DRCOG's Central Area General Improvement District (CAGID) and City of Boulder Mobility Hub project in an amount not to exceed \$250,000 for a period of 16 months from the date of contract execution.
