Resolution No. 37, 2025

A resolution authorizing the Executive Director to negotiate and execute a contract with WSP USA to provide GIS and data analysis services for DRCOG's Bike+ Data Fusion Activity Model project in an amount not to exceed \$400,000 for a period of 24 months from the date of contract execution.

Whereas, DRCOG established the Innovative Mobility set-aside program to assist regional partners as they plan for, and prepare, innovative solutions to mobility challenges in the Denver region; and

Whereas, a total of four million dollars is available in the set-aside over the four-year period of the 2024-2027 Transportation Improvement Program; and

Whereas, the Bike+ Data Fusion Activity Model project was approved by the DRCOG board in December 2024 and seeks to develop a travel model of Bike+ activity in the jurisdictions of Denver and Boulder.

Whereas, DRCOG conducted a competitive bidding process administered by a selection panel consisting of staff from DRCOG's Active and Emerging Mobility team, Subarea and Project Planning team, and contracting team as well as the City and County of Denver's Department of Transportation and Infrastructure travel model and bicycle planning teams and the City of Boulder's Transportation team; and

Whereas, the selection panel determined that WSP submitted the best overall proposal that demonstrated their experience, capability and understanding to successfully deliver the required services.

Now, therefore, be it resolved that the Finance and Budget Committee authorizes the Executive Director to negotiate and execute a contract with WSP USA to provide GIS and data analysis services for DRCOG's Bike+ Data Fusion Activity Model project in an amount not to exceed \$400,000 for a period of 24 months from the date of contract execution.
