Summary

July 2026 administrative modifications to the 2026-2029 Transportation Improvement Program.

Background

Per the Board-adopted [Policies for Transportation Improvement Program Development](#), administrative modifications to the [2026-2029 Transportation Improvement Program](#) are reviewed and processed by staff. Administrative modifications represent revisions to projects that do not require formal action by the Board of Directors.

After the Board is informed of the administrative modifications, the modifications are processed and posted on the [Transportation Improvement Program web page](#). They are then emailed to the Transportation Improvement Program Notification List, which includes members of the Transportation Advisory Committee, the Regional Transportation Committee, project sponsors, staff of various federal and state agencies, and other interested parties.

Please note the Federal Transit Administration Section 5310 funding action (TIP Project # 2022-025 listed below) is contingent upon Board approval of the TIP amendments at the July 15 Board of Directors meeting.

Project funding transfer:

These projects involve funding transfers from one project to another. In many cases, this might be the consolidation of funding from multiple project listings into a single listing, or the merger of adjacent similar projects that will involve a combined letting. Projects are shown below paired with the other project(s) that are part of the transfer.

Under this action, \$15 million in anticipated RAISE funding in the CO119 project, which has not yet been awarded, is being removed and swapped with funding from the Region 4 RPP Pool, Transportation Commission Contingency funds, and FASTER Safety funds.
