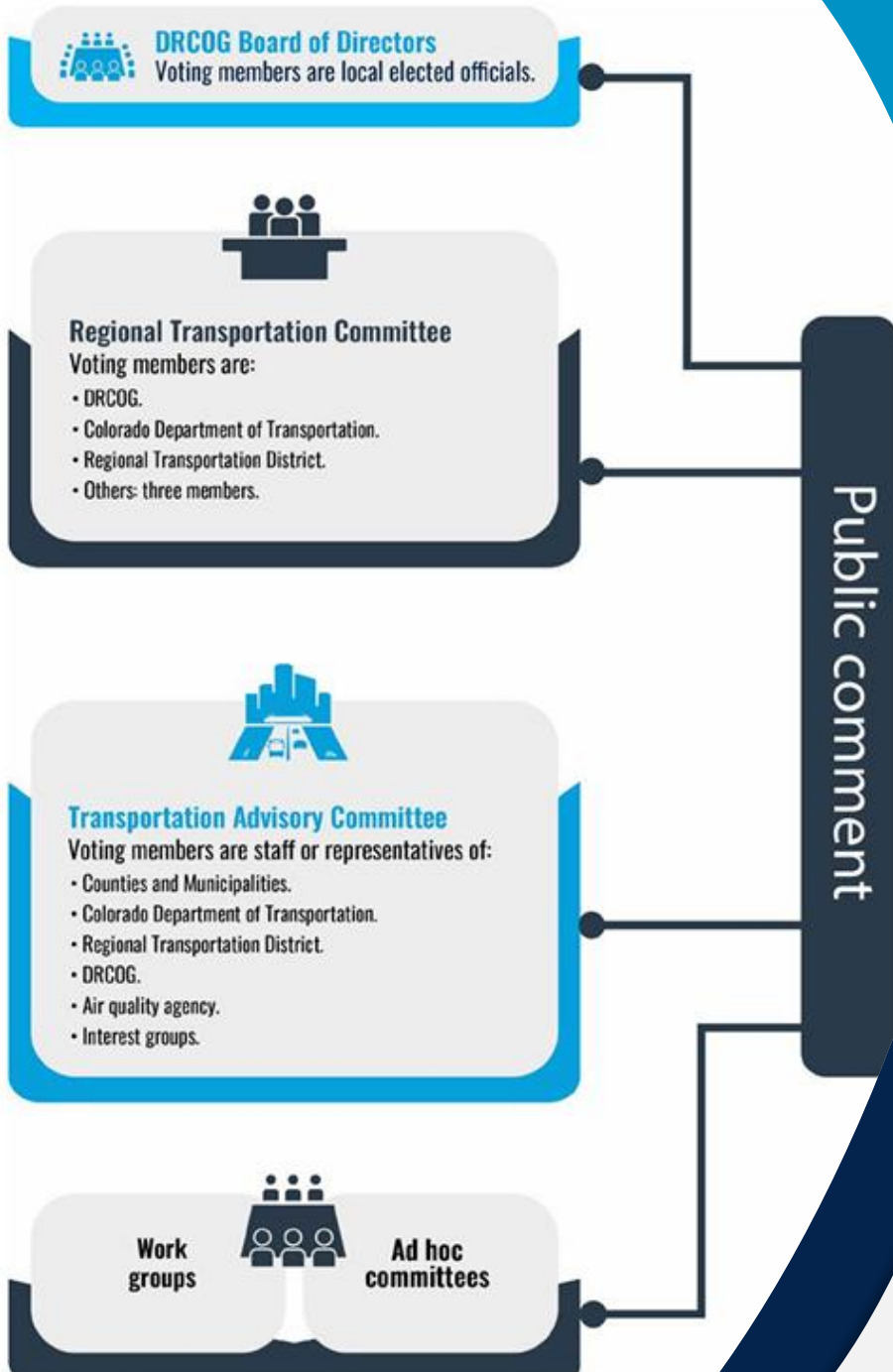




Annual Review of Transportation Advisory Committee Membership

Transportation Advisory Committee's role

- "...to assist the Board of Directors and the Regional Transportation Committee by **reviewing the work** of the transportation planning process, **advising on methods** of planning and implementation, **working with the metropolitan planning organization staff** to develop policy options, and **making recommendations** to the Regional Transportation Committee."

Transportation Advisory Committee membership

- **20 local government** representatives. (Counties, cities, towns)
- **1 non-MPO area** representatives.
(Clear Creek and Gilpin counties, eastern Adams and Arapahoe counties)
- **4 CDOT** representatives.
- **1 DRCOG** representative.
- **1 RAQC** representative.
- **1 RTD** representative.
- **1 Via Mobility** representative.
- **9 special interest seats.**
 - Aviation.
 - Business.
 - Environment.
 - Equity.
 - Freight.
 - Housing.
 - Non-motorized.
 - Older Adults.
 - Transportation demand management.
- Ex-officio **FWHA** and **FTA** representatives

Annual review

- **Goal:** Maintain the close bond between the Chair, RTC, and the membership and work of the TAC.
 - The DRCOG Board Chair and RTC **review the membership of the TAC annually.**
 - RTC also **approves the TAC's Special Interest Seat representatives** that are nominated by the Chair.
- From staff's perspective, there is a **strong core of local government representatives** and **alternates** who attend regularly and provide valuable input.
- The **Special Interest Seat representatives** also contribute meaningfully to TAC's work.

2026 annual review

- There are **occasional periods of transition** based on local government staff changes, and the roster reflects a few local government member or alternate vacancies staff are currently working with the forums to fill.
 - **Adams County:** 2 vacancies.
 - **Douglas County:** 1 vacancy.
- Of the nine special interest seats, **one of them is at term** and there is **one vacancy**:
 - **Non-motorized (Active transportation):** Sue Prant. (**Vacancy**)
 - **Equity:** Angie Rivera-Malpiede. (**At term**)

Recommendation

- Move to approve the special interest seat representatives nominated by the DRCOG Board Chair.





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
