Regional Transportation Operations and Technology Strategic Plan

- Regional Transportation Operations and Technology Strategic Plan guides regional investment in transportation technology and systems.
 - **Purpose:** collaboratively manage systems to safely and optimally serve multijurisdictional and multimodal operations.
 - **Primary initiatives:** improve understanding of transportation system conditions and dynamically coordinate operations across all modes and jurisdictions.
- Regional Transportation Operations and Technology Set-aside funds regional investment in transportation technology and systems.

Set-aside application process overview

- Schedule:
 - April 16: Call-for-projects initiated.
 - May 1: Letters of interest due.
 - May 20: Letter of interest forum.
 - July 10: Applications due.
- Review panel individually evaluated and scored the applications as per Policies for FY 2024-2028 TIP Set-Aside Programs.
- Review panel developed recommendations based on combined scoring and value to the region.
