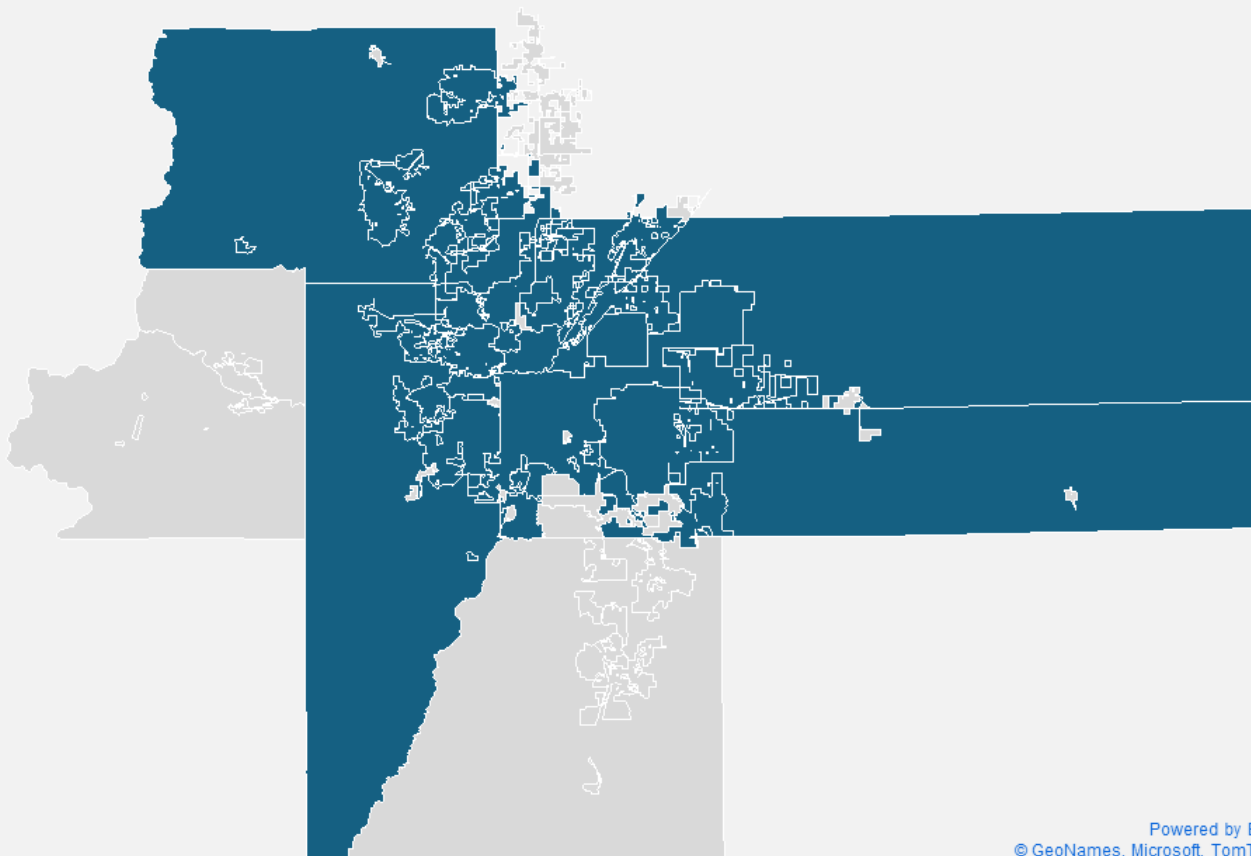

Jurisdictional Subawards

Geographic Distribution of Funds



1. Support jurisdictions in BPC participation to develop a regional building efficiency and electrification roadmap and jointly address policy adoption, implementation and enforcement challenges.
2. Support jurisdictions' staff capacity to adopt and implement local building policies, maximizing regional consistency.
3. 27 jurisdictions awarded representing 85% of the population in the DRCOG region.
4. Obligated \$26.25 million of \$34.8 million available, ~75% of total funds.



Subaward Round 2

- \$6.55 million
- Round 2 Goals:
 - Incentivize new participation to build regional momentum on core policies.
 - Increase impact for existing awardees.
 - Allow for more innovative and ambitious applications.
- Same eligibility criteria and eligible uses as Round 1.
- Expanded eligible uses
- Eligible award amounts \$100,000 - \$750,000

Round 2 Results

- 14 applications received totaling \$7,033,139 (\$502,367 average)
- \$481,139 (6.87%) oversubscribed.
- Review panel consisting of four DRCOG staff scored all applications.
- All applications we're deemed qualifying and responsive to eligibility criteria.





Evaluation Panel Recommendation

- Apply a 6.87% reduction to all applications
- Provides guaranteed funding for all applicants at 93.13%
- Reduction is small enough for applicants to absorb without the need to renegotiate major scope items.
