

The Denver Regional Council of Governments (DRCOG) is soliciting requests for eligible Regional Share and Subregional Share projects for the 2022-2025 Transportation Improvement Program. This Call for Projects will exclusively be used to add projects to existing waiting lists, in anticipation of future available funding. There is no funding available to program to projects with this call.

This announcement serves as the official DRCOG Supplemental Wait List Call for Projects for the 2022-2025 TIP. No funding is currently available to program to projects; all recommended projects will be added to the appropriate Regional or Subregional Share TIP Waiting List.

Call for Projects Guidelines:

- Application forms and other data to assist you in filling out your requests can be found [here](#). If applicants need additional data from DRCOG for the completion of their application, they must contact DRCOG staff **no later than June 1** with their request.
- Project sponsors must have attended one of the mandatory [TIP submittal training workshops](#) associated with the previous 20-23 TIP back in 2018. If you are aware no one from your agency attended or are unsure, please contact [staff](#).
- Project submittal limitations by subregional forum and sponsor are placed on this call. [See below for details](#).
- Detailed information about sponsor and project eligibility for each share is contained within the [2020-2023 TIP Policy](#).
- Projects requiring CDOT and/or RTD concurrence must provide their official response within their application submittal. The CDOT/RTD concurrence request is due to CDOT/RTD no later than May 5, with CDOT/RTD providing a response no later than June 4. The concurrence form can be found [here](#). - The project sponsor will submit application(s) to DRCOG, who will confirm project eligibility and score submittals against the evaluation criteria defined in the TIP Policy. A project review panel will be convened to review the scores and prepare a recommendation to the DRCOG committees and Board of Directors.
- Selected projects will be placed on the appropriate waiting list in score order, beginning [after](#) any existing wait list project(s).
- Project sponsors must submit completed applications and support materials electronically to Josh Schwenk at jschwenk@drcog.org by **3 p.m. on Monday, June 21**.

DRCOG recently programmed approximately \$55 million in federal funds to wait list projects. To maintain a prioritized list of [wait list projects](#) for possible additional federal funding, DRCOG will consider adding projects to wait lists to maintain approximately one year of estimated federal funding apportionments (\$75 million). Submittal limitations are as follows:

- **Regional Share Waiting List:** Each eligible project sponsor may submit a maximum of one application for consideration. The final panel recommendation will be capped at approximately \$15 million in DRCOG funding requests.
- **Subregional Share Waiting Lists:**

Subregions Allowed to Submit

- Adams County Subregion: Each eligible project sponsor within the subregion may submit a maximum of two applications for consideration. The final panel recommendation will be capped at approximately \$6.3 million in DRCOG funding requests.
- Jefferson County Subregion: Each eligible project sponsor within the subregion may submit a maximum of two applications for consideration. The final panel recommendation will be capped at approximately \$5.9 million in DRCOG funding requests.
- SW Weld County Subregion: Each eligible project sponsor within the subregion may submit a maximum of two applications for consideration. The final panel recommendation will be capped at approximately \$1.6 million in DRCOG funding requests.

Subregions Not Allowed to Submit

- Arapahoe County Subregion: The existing waiting list includes \$19.6 million of DRCOG requests, which exceeds one years' worth of estimated federal funding (\$11.6 million); no subregional share project submittals will be accepted.
- Boulder County Subregion: The existing waiting list includes \$13.8 million of DRCOG requests, which exceeds one years' worth of estimated federal funding (\$5.8 million); no subregional share project submittals will be accepted.
- Broomfield City/County Subregion: The existing waiting list includes \$2.2 million of DRCOG requests, which exceeds one years' worth of estimated federal funding (\$1.4 million); no subregional share project submittals will be accepted.
- Denver City/County Subregion: The existing waiting list includes \$63.2 million of DRCOG requests, which exceeds one years' worth of estimated federal funding (\$14.6 million); no subregional share project submittals will be accepted.
- Douglas County Subregion: The existing waiting list includes \$6.8 million of DRCOG requests, which exceeds one years' worth of estimated federal funding (\$6 million); no subregional share project submittals will be accepted.

Please note that although applications are being submitted to DRCOG directly and no forum action is needed, forums are encouraged to discuss the applications individual members intend to submit.
