



2024-2027 TIP regional share call for projects

The Denver Regional Council of Governments is soliciting requests for funding of eligible regional share projects to develop the new 2024-2027 Transportation Improvement Program. This is the **third** of four calls for projects to allocate fiscal years 2022 through 2027 funds to both the current 2022-2025 TIP and a new 2024-2027 TIP.

This announcement serves as the official notice of the DRCOG regional share call for projects for fiscal year 2024-2027 TIP projects, also known as Call 3. A total amount of \$49.194 million is available under this call. **Two** applications will be utilized:

- One application will be for air quality and multimodal projects only ([AQ/MM Application](#)) and utilize available 2025, 2026 and 2027 funding including federal Congestion Mitigation/Air Quality, federal Transportation Alternatives, federal Carbon Reduction Program, and state Multimodal Transportation and Mitigation Options Funds. An estimated \$21.105 million will be available for this application.
- A second application will utilize federal Surface Transportation Block Grant funding only ([STBG Application](#)). Eligibility is expanded to include roadway capacity projects, roadway reconstruction projects and bridge projects, in addition to most project types eligible under the Air Quality and Multimodal application. An estimated \$28.089 million will be available under this application.

Call for projects guidelines:

- The call is being conducted under guidance set within the adopted [Policies for TIP Program Development](#). A [quick guide](#) is also available.
- Project sponsors must have attended **at least one** of the two previous TIP trainings in February 2022 to be eligible to submit an application. If no one from your agency attended, or if you'd like to confirm someone did attend, please contact [DRCOG staff](#).
- Projects requiring Colorado Department of Transportation and/or Regional Transportation District concurrence must submit [request forms](#) to those agencies no later than Sept. 2.

- The two applications, along with additional call details, can be found on the [2024-2027 TIP Development](#) webpage. In addition to the information found on the webpage, the first page of each application contains relevant information.
- Transportation and other data to assist applicants in completing their application can be obtained from the [2024-2027 TIP Data Resources](#) webpage. Details include a link to the TIP Data Hub, which includes the TIP Data Tool (a web mapping tool to assist applicants with spatial analysis questions on the application) and links to download data for use outside of the TIP Data Tool.
- A maximum of three applications are allowed to be submitted from each subregional forum and two each from CDOT and RTD for this call. Each forum must approve of their submittals.
- Project sponsors must submit application(s) and other required and optional documentation from a link located within the TIP Data Hub no later than **3 p.m. on Tuesday, Oct. 11**.
- DRCOG staff will confirm project eligibility, score submittals, and relay the scores to a project review panel. The week of Oct. 31, the panel will review scores and prepare a recommendation to the DRCOG committees and Board of Directors. Action is anticipated in December.
- All projects selected as a result of this call and the upcoming Call 4, will be included as part of a new 2024-2027 TIP anticipated to be adopted by the DRCOG Board in August 2023.
