There are a number of reasons we urge you to reconsider putting funding towards the Peña Blvd widening, the first being that, as you all know, we've had a big shift in Denver leadership this week, and Mayor Johnston deserves the opportunity to weight in on whether a project this significant is aligned with his vision for the city and if it should move forward. Next, the Peña Blvd master planning process is still underway. Moving this funding forward now would put the cart before the horse and undermine the process to identify what the corridor actually needs and what's in line with our city's values. Further, in light of the recently adopted greenhouse gas planning standard for transportation and new federal opportunities for investment in transit, widening projects like this seem out of touch and again seem inconsistent with state, regional, and local efforts and goals to address climate change and air pollution. Finally, there are a lot of projects on Denver's waiting list, including a number of trail and multimodal projects, that could be funded for the same amount as Peña Blvd. They're just more clearly aligned with Denver's priorities and could actually improve the day to day lives of Denverites. We urge you to press pause on funding the Peña Blvd widening during this final phase of the TIP process. Thank you for your time and consideration this evening.
