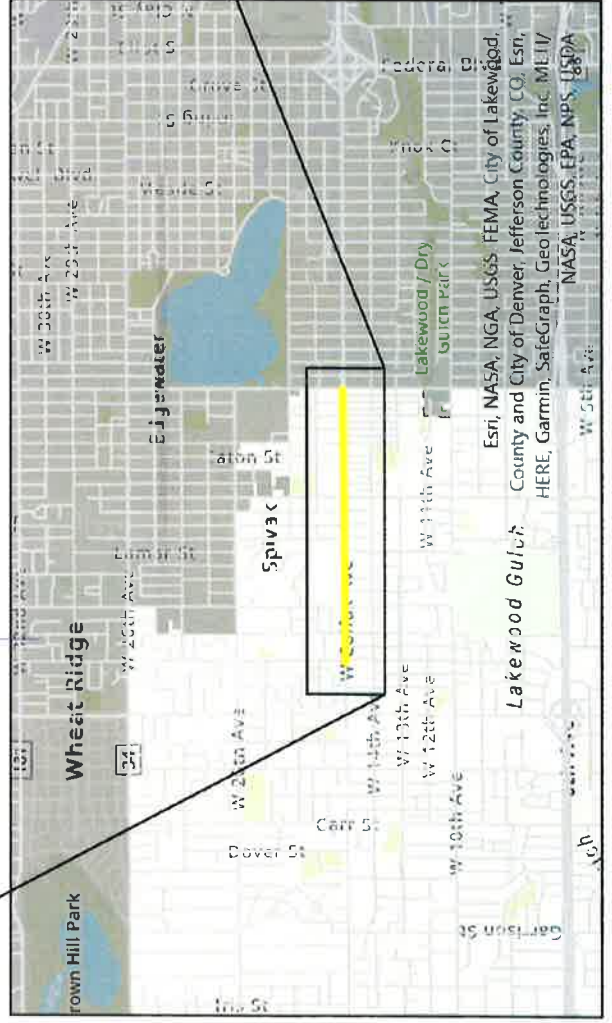

Overall project work includes: repurposing vehicle lanes into detached sidewalks with buffered landscaping, intersection and non-intersection treatments to help guide pedestrians and motorists, improved median treatments, and innovative technology. Due to construction inflation, discoveries and further design refinements the original project is underfunded.

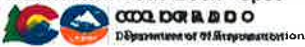
