Veteran Directed Care

Flexible solutions for your well-being and independence

Veteran Directed Care serves eligible veterans of any age who are at risk of placement in long-term care, like a nursing home. Veteran Directed Care helps veterans receive home- and community-based services that enable them to continue to live in their homes and communities for as long as possible. There are no requirements for service connected disability, financial eligibility or disability rating to participate.

Veteran Directed Care allows veterans to:

- Decide what help they need, when they need it and who provides it.
- Work with a case manager to develop a personalized spending and service plan.
- Decide what goods and services best meet their care needs, and the needs of their caregiver.
- Manage a flexible, individual budget.
- Hire and oversee workers, including family or friends.
- Buy items or acquire services to live independently in the community.



Veteran Directed Care includes:

- Case management services.
- A flexible monthly budget for goods and services such as:
 - in-home personal care
 - homemaker services
 - caregiver support
 - adult day care
 - environmental support
 - transportation
