Resolution No. 33, 2024

A resolution authorizing the Executive Director to distribute up to \$500,000 in federal fiscal year 2025 NSIP funds to contracted nutrition providers.

Whereas, Congress is anticipated to authorize and appropriate NSIP funds for the nutrition program in federal fiscal year 2025 under the provisions of Title III of the Older Americans Act (OAA), as amended, and distribute the funds to states; and

Whereas, through the State Unit on Aging division of the Colorado Department of Human Services it is anticipated that 2025 NSIP funds will be allocated proportionately to the Area Agencies on Aging; and

Whereas, the Denver Regional Council of Governments is designated by the State to receive and distribute NSIP funds as the Area Agency on Aging for the eight-county metro region; and

Whereas, the Denver Regional Council of Governments will distribute the NSIP funds to contracted OAA nutrition providers for the purchase of domestically produced food items;

Now, therefore, be it resolved that the Finance and Budget Committee authorizes the Executive Director to distribute up to \$500,000 in federal fiscal year 2025 NSIP funds to contracted nutrition providers.
