Resolution No. 54, 2025

A resolution authorizing the Executive Director to accept approximately \$500,000 of Nutrition Services Incentives Program funding from the Colorado Department of Health and Human Services and distribute that funding to nutrition providers in the region for the period ending September 30, 2026.

Whereas, Congress is anticipated to authorize and appropriate NSIP funds for nutrition programs in federal fiscal year 2026 under the provisions of Title III of the Older Americans Act (OAA) and distribute the funds to states; and

Whereas, DRCOG as the designated Area Agency on Aging for the eight-county metro region is the designated recipient of NSIP funding passed through by the Colorado Department of Health and Human Services; and

Whereas; DRCOG must distribute the NSIP funding to contracted nutrition providers under the Older Americans Act to purchase domestically produced food.

Now, therefore, be it resolved that the Finance and Budget Committee of the Denver Regional Council of Governments hereby authorizes the Executive to accept approximately \$500,000 of Nutrition Services Incentives Program funding from the Colorado Department of Health and Human Services and distribute that funding to nutrition providers in the region for the period ending September 30, 2026.
