

Sharing Civic Academy content on social media

Tips and best practices for taking photos, videos, posting and tagging.

Best practices for photography:

- 1. Vertical pictures are best for mobile users.
- 2. Take photography in good lighting. Avoid too-bright or dim conditions.
- Be as close as possible to your subject.(Zooming in can work, but not too much.)
- 4. Use action shots.
- Don't forget a caption and to include the hashtag #CivicChat with your description.


Best practices for recording videos:

- Landscape (horizontal) orientation is best for online use.
- Have good lighting. Avoid too-bright or dim conditions.
- Make sure your audio is clear and minimize background noise.
- 4. Limit your video time to one minute maximum (30 seconds is average).
- Don't forget a caption and to include the hashtag #CivicChat with your description.


How to post your photo or video and tag accounts:

- 1. On Facebook, tap the space asking "What's on your mind?" and click on the green photo/ video icon (refer to the example screenshot).
- 2. Add your photo or video. In the "Say something about this photo ..." field, add your caption and then tag the Denver Regional Council of Governments by typing
- @Denver.Regional.Council.of.Governments.

The Facebook profile for DRCOG will automatically appear. Tap or click on it to add the tag to your caption and photo (refer to the example screenshot).



- 3. After adding the tag and finishing your caption, hit "Post!"
- 4. The same process can be applied to other social media platforms.
