Resolution No. 55, 2025

A resolution authorizing the Executive Director to amend a contract with Lotus Engineering and Sustainability supporting Decarbonization DRCOG's Building Policy Collaborative to increase the first term of the contract in an amount not to exceed \$2,220,000, with an initial term date of September 30, 2027 with the option to renew for two additional one-year terms for a total contract amount not to exceed \$2,700,000.

Whereas, DRCOG received a \$199.7 million grant from the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency's Climate Pollution Reduction Grant program to implement a regional building decarbonization initiative; and

Whereas, within this program lies the Building Policy Collaborative (BPC), which will support DRCOG jurisdictions over the next five years to implement new, above-state minimum building energy codes and performance standards, and consists of a vast peer-to-peer network where jurisdictions can collaborate and problem solve policy adoption and implementation barriers and receive technical support from DRCOG to help overcome these policy barriers; and

Whereas, DRCOG awarded Lotus a contract to help facilitate the BPC due to their extensive experience in the region as well as their expertise on building decarbonization policies, and their ability to provide ongoing technical support to the local governments throughout the next four years; and

Whereas, DRCOG has committed research support for the participating jurisdictions, which will evaluate the largest barriers to policy adoption and implementation and provide solutions that will be used by participating jurisdictions to inform and advocate for improved policy to their counsels and the public; and

Whereas, Lotus' existing contract includes some research capacity, but not enough to support the growing and immediate needs of the jurisdictions to answer certain policy related questions which have been identified needing further research.

Now, therefore, be it resolved that the Finance and Budget Committee authorizes the Executive Director to amend a contract with Lotus Engineering and Sustainability supporting Decarbonization DRCOG's Building Policy Collaborative to increase the first term of the contract in an amount not to exceed \$2,220,000, with an initial term date of September 30, 2027 with the option to renew for two additional one-year terms for a total contract amount not to exceed \$2,700,000.
