## DRCOG Multimodal Local Development Standards Toolkit Project Overview

### Summary

Update on the *Built to Move: A DRCOG Toolkit for Multimodal-Supportive Local Development Standards* project.

### Background

The Denver Regional Council of Governments (DRCOG) is currently developing *Built to Move: A DRCOG Toolkit for Multimodal-Supportive Local Development Standards*. This implementation-based project will provide local governments with strategies and standards that advance multimodal connectivity and access within urban, suburban, and rural community contexts. The toolkit will include the following:

- 1) Case Studies: Highlight effective multimodal-supportive development practices from peer jurisdictions, summarizing implementation lessons and key takeaways relevant to DRCOG's member communities.
- 2) Land Development Code Strategies: Provide guidance on regulatory approaches that advance multimodal access, paired with optional code language to accommodate jurisdictions with varying capacities.
- 3) Implementation Strategies: Define implementation roles for DRCOG and member governments, identify coordination opportunities, develop technical assistance approaches, and propose metrics for tracking outcomes.
- 4) Community Engagement: Engage community members and relevant stakeholders through focus groups, intercept events, a developer roundtable, and a DRCOG staff capacity-building workshop.

The toolkit will serve as a practical resource enabling local governments to integrate multimodal-supportive standards into development review processes. It will provide adaptable, context-sensitive approaches to improve mobility options, safety, and access across the DRCOG region, ultimately supporting regional growth, sustainability, and Vision Zero objectives.
