Summary

October 2025 administrative modifications to the 2026-2029 Transportation Improvement Program.

Background

Per the Board-adopted [Policies for Transportation Improvement Program Development](#), administrative modifications to the [2026-2029 Transportation Improvement Program](#) are reviewed and processed by staff. Administrative modifications represent revisions to projects that do not require formal action by the Board of Directors.

After the Board is informed of the administrative modifications, the modifications are processed and posted on the [Transportation Improvement Program web page](#). They are then emailed to the Transportation Improvement Program Notification List, which includes members of the Transportation Advisory Committee, the Regional Transportation Committee, project sponsors, staff of various federal and state agencies, and other interested parties.

| New project | CDOT Region 4 | CO66 and 75th Street Intersection Operational Improvements | Add new project | Add \$2,000,000 in state Legislative funding. |
