Resolution No. 37, 2024

A resolution authorizing the Executive Director to accept funds from the Colorado Department of Local Affairs, Colorado's Energy and Mineral Impact Assistance Fund, in the amount of \$200,000 for a one-year term to support the development of a regional housing strategy.

Whereas, the Denver Regional Council of Governments, as the Metropolitan Planning Organization, is responsible for carrying out and maintaining the continuing, cooperative, and comprehensive transportation and housing coordination planning process in the Greater Denver Transportation Management Area; and

Whereas, Denver Regional Council of Governments applied to the More Housing Now Set Aside program of the Energy and Mineral Impact Fund with the Department of Local Affairs to support the components of the development of a regional housing strategy; and

Whereas, the Department of Local Affairs announced the award of \$200,000 from the Energy and Mineral Impact Fund to Denver Regional Council of Governments to support the development of a regional housing strategy;

Now, therefore, be it resolved that the Finance and Budget Committee authorizes the Executive Director to accept funds from the Colorado Department of Local Affairs, Colorado's Energy and Mineral Impact Assistance Fund, in the amount of \$200,000 for a one-year term to support the development of a regional housing strategy.
