Resolution No. 36, 2024

A resolution authorizing the Executive Director to negotiate and execute a contract with Toole Design for the Brighton Core Circulation Study in an amount not to exceed \$300,000 and for a term of 14 months from the date of contract execution.

Whereas, this study is part of DRCOG's Community-Based Transportation Planning 2024-2027 set-aside program which focuses on supporting member governments' efforts to improve transportation for historically marginalized communities; and

Whereas, the study area in Brighton is a 2-mile stretch of Bridge Street between the South Platte River and 22nd Avenue and up to a half mile on either side of Bridge Street; and

Whereas, DRCOG conducted a competitive bidding process and a selection committee of staff from DRCOG, City of Brighton, and JMS Strategies, Inc. determined that Toole Design had the best proposal; and

Whereas, the selected consultant has demonstrated qualifications developing multimodal transportation circulation plans, specifically focused on improving safety and multimodal mobility for underserved communities; and

Whereas, DRCOG is finalizing a contract with CDOT to accept \$1.25 million of funds from the 2024-2027 Transportation Improvement Program for the Community-based Transportation Planning set-aside for federal fiscal years 2024-2025, of which \$300,000 is budgeted for the Brighton Core Circulation Study.

Now, therefore, be it resolved that the Finance and Budget Committee authorizes the Executive Director to negotiate and execute a contract with Toole Design for the Brighton Core Circulation Study in an amount not to exceed \$300,000 and for a term of 14 months from the date of contract execution.
