Innovation Pilot Grant Program Introduction

Summary

Power Ahead Colorado and VEIC staff will provide an update and guided discussion on the Innovation Pilot Grant Program, a \$6 million initiative designed to accelerate building electrification and energy efficiency adoption through regional pilot projects.

Background

The program takes inspiration from the TECH Clean California initiative, which awarded \$3.85 million to 19 projects between 2021–2024 to accelerate adoption of clean heating technologies. These pilots demonstrated the effectiveness of targeted, scalable approaches for overcoming barriers such as emergency replacement scenarios, utility allowance misalignment, and deployment in disadvantaged communities.

DRCOG's \$6 million Innovation Pilot Grant Program will award average subgrants of \$200,000 to support community-driven innovations and small business-led projects. The program's goals are to:

- Demonstrate scalable solutions to persistent market barriers.
- Inform decarbonization decision-making with public data, analysis, and case studies.
- Support entrepreneurial approaches and underserved communities in adopting clean technologies.

The Power Ahead Colorado Technical Committee will participate in grant criteria development and award selection processes.

VEIC staff will update the committee with a deeper dive into the program logic framework, goals and ongoing work. The committee will be invited to participate in discussion and feedback to help inform grant criteria and program design direction.
