Amendments to the Fiscal Year 2024-2027 Transportation Improvement Program

Summary

Consider approval of February 2025 Amendments to the Fiscal Year 2024-2027 Transportation Improvement Program, known as the TIP.

Background

The region's transportation planning process allows for Board-approved amendments to the current TIP on an as-needed basis. Typically, these amendments involve the addition or deletion of projects, or adjustments to existing projects and do not impact funding for other projects in the Transportation Improvement Program.

These proposed amendments to the <u>2024-2027 TIP</u> are summarized in the below table and detailed in the attachment. They have been found to conform with the State Implementation Plan for Air Quality.
