

Senate Bill 25-030: Planned bicycle, pedestrian and transit project inventory

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What is Senate Bill 25-030?

Senate Bill 25-030 requires metropolitan planning organizations and the Colorado Department of Transportation to compile planned bicycle, pedestrian and transit project inventories across the state.

DRCOG is required to collect these projects from local governments of over 5,000 people in the Denver metropolitan planning organization area.



What types of projects should be included?

Planned projects can come from a variety of plans (such as capital improvement, long range, subarea, transportation) and can include maybe project types including, but not limited to:

- **Bicycle** infrastructure (travelways or supportive infrastructure).
- **Pedestrian** infrastructure (sidewalks or supportive infrastructure).
- Transit service and facilities (fixed-route or on-demand).







What type of information should be included for each planned project?

- Project name.
- Primary project type.
- Project location.
- Plan(s) containing the project.


If additional information about the location, length, cost, description or other details are available you can include them.

What projects do not need to be included?

This inventory does **not** need to capture transit operations or maintenance of existing routes and services, active transportation education or encouragement programs, plans or studies, data collection efforts or count programs.







How should project lists be submitted to DRCOG?

Please use the form linked to in the memo to upload your planned project information.

We can accept a variety of file types, but prefer shapefiles or spreadsheets.



When do local governments need to submit projects to DRCOG?

The legislative deadline is December 31, 2025. Local governments are welcome to submit anytime before then!
