Coordinated Transit Plan

- Federal requirement, **last updated in 2021.**
- Creates inventory of **existing transit services.**
- Identifies **top regional needs and gaps** for specific communities.
- Sets strategies to **address mobility needs.**
- Guides **5310 and Human-Services Transportation** projects.



2021 Coordinated Transit Plan- State of Transit

Top 5 Needs and Gaps

- Improve access to health care for non-emergency visits.
- Affordable fares for older adults and individuals with disabilities.
- Expand services to meet increased demand.
- Increase cross-jurisdictional trips.
- Better regional and local coordination.

Top 5 Strategic Priorities

- First- and last-mile connections.
- Spend funding more efficiently.
- Improve access to key services (i.e. healthcare, employment).
- Affordable fare programming.
- Increase human services transportation coordination efforts.

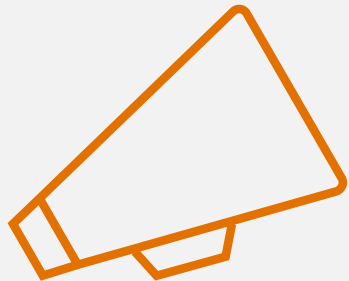

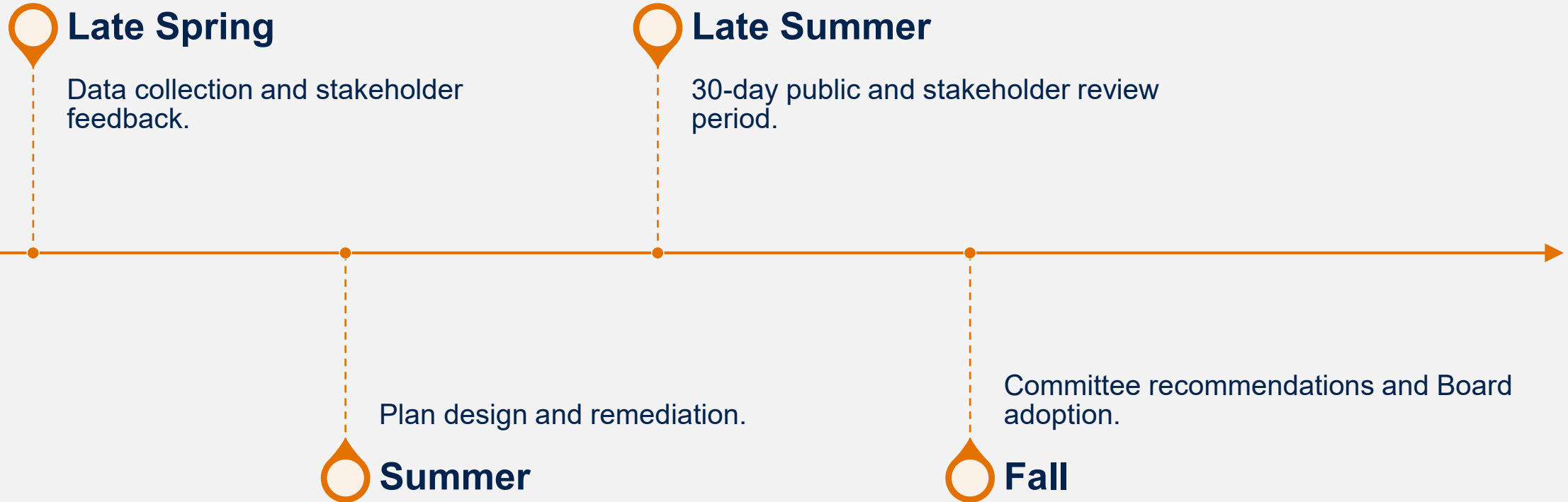
