Resolution No. 2, 2026

A resolution adopting the Active Transportation Plan.

Whereas, the Denver Regional Council of Governments, as the metropolitan planning organization, is responsible for carrying out and maintaining the continuing comprehensive transportation planning process designed to prepare and adopt regional transportation plans and programs; and

Whereas, the urban transportation planning process in the Denver region is carried out through cooperative agreement between the Denver Regional Council of Governments, the Regional Transportation District, and the Colorado Department of Transportation; and

Whereas, the Denver Regional Council of Governments is committed to planning a connected, multimodal region; and

Whereas, the 2026 update to the Active Transportation Plan describes a vision, themes and network for implementing a complete, connected and comprehensive walking and bicycling network for the Denver region; and

Whereas, the draft Active Transportation Plan was the subject of a 32-day public comment period ending on September 1, 2025; and

Whereas, the Transportation Advisory Committee and the Regional Transportation Committee have recommended adoption of the Active Transportation Plan.

Now, therefore, be it resolved that the Board of Directors of the Denver Regional Council of Governments hereby adopts the Active Transportation Plan.
