Advanced Mobility Partnership Annual Update

Summary

Staff will provide an update on the Advanced Mobility Partnership activities throughout 2025.

Background

The Advanced Mobility Partnership is a collective effort between the Denver Regional Council of Governments, Regional Transportation District, Colorado Department of Transportation and the Denver Metro Chamber of Commerce to implement the region's Mobility Choice Blueprint.

In 2025, the Advanced Mobility Partnership Working Group convened to discuss innovative topics and share information on a variety of emerging trends. Working group presentations included examples from regional and statewide programs as well as a guest presentation from the City of Portland, Oregon. Topics discussed throughout 2025 included: innovative mobility funding sources, automated vehicles, connected work zone data standards, bike plus data collection and electric vehicle charging technologies.

In addition to the working group, AMP Executive Committee meets twice a year to discuss areas for coordination. In 2025, the committee discussed three main areas for future coordination including digital trip planning and payment, microtransit coordination, and DRCOG's Innovative Mobility Set-Aside.

The Advanced Mobility Partnership Working Group meets every even month of the year. This year's meetings will be held on February 3, April 7, August 4, October 6 and December 8 at 2:30pm.
