1. DRCOG MVRTP

- Jacob Riger discussed the status and remaining schedule for the current amendment cycle, including the March 21st public hearing.
- The group discussed possible future 2040 MVRTP amendment cycle schedule implications due to a potential transportation ballot measure.

2. DRCOG TIP

- 2018-2021 TIP: Todd Cottrell noted a potential policy amendment for I-70 Central, with discussion about potentially holding the amendment and grouping it with other amendments that will be coming in the next couple months.
- TIP delays: The DRCOG Board approved 2017 project delays last week.
- 2020-2023 TIP: Todd and Doug Rex noted that the DRCOG Board approved the regional/subregional allocation split and the regional projects eligibility framework. The TIP Policy Working Group is currently working on the subregional forums process.
- Todd summarized the January 23rd meeting with CDOT, FHWA, and CDOT regarding TIP and STIP coordination and alignment.

3. Other DRCOG Items

- Jacob and DRCOG staff provided updates on other DRCOG activities, including the Active Transportation Plan, the current call for TDM projects, the VTCLI (Veterans Transportation Community Living Initiative) project, and other activities.
- NFRMPO staff shared that they are updating their regional travel model and preparing a regional transit element. They also noted NFRMPO decided to support CDOT's safety targets.

4. Federal MPO Performance Targets
 - Jacob noted DRCOG adopted 2018 safety targets at its January Board meeting. There was discussion about whom at CDOT should receive DRCOG's letter documenting its adoption of the 2018 safety targets.

5. CDOT-Region 1 and 4 updates
 - R1 "4P" meetings are starting next week. WestConnect PEL public meetings are also underway.
 - R4 held county meetings last year, so are not formally holding "4P" meetings, though R4 staff will attend the Broomfield City/County 4P meeting. R4 staff noted that contracts are being finalized for I-25 North, with construction starting this summer.

6. RTD/transit updates
 - Chris Quinn said RTD is under contract with UrbanTrans for the First and Final Mile study. The Regional BRT study is also starting. He also gave an update on the Pass Program Working Group process.

7. FHWA/FTA updates
 - Bill Hass discussed staffing changes at FHWA, and noted that Darin Allen is the FTA contact for the time being. Bill also noted the hyperloop feasibility study and a demonstration this calendar year for the proposed Arrivo technology.

- DRCOG updates
 - Jacob Riger updated the ICG on the 2017 Amendments to the 2040 MVRTP.
 - Robert Spotts shared the emission results for PM10, CO, VOC, and NOx demonstrating that all MVEBs were met, demonstrating conformity.
- NFRMPO updates
 - Becky Karasko updated the ICG on the North Front Range's work with CDOT regarding the hybrid/rolling TIP.
- RAQC updates
 - Amanda Brimmer gave an update that the EPA has not yet made attainment/nonattainment designations for the 2015 ozone standard. RAQC anticipates EPA to approve the same nonattainment area geography. Still waiting on new classification under the 2015 ozone standard. EPA has an April deadline to provide the classification.
