1. DRCOG MVRTP

- Jacob Riger recapped the March 21st public hearing and reviewed the remaining adoption schedule for the 2040 MVRTP.
- Kristin Kenyon asked how the Mobility Choice Blueprint effort relates to the 2040 MVRTP.

2. DRCOG TIP

- 2018-2021 TIP: Todd Cottrell noted there were no new policy amendments this month. For the current TIP amendments, Todd summarized coordination with Adams County on CDOT-proposed funding adjustments (not amounts) to the US-85/Vasquez Blvd. operational improvements project.
- Project delays: Todd explained that staff sends out the list twice a year to get project status updates.
- 2020-2023 TIP: Todd noted the regional share application review process and criteria will be discussed at the April Board Work Session. There was group discussion about the need to coordinate on training. Danny Hermann said DRCOG and CDOT need to stay aligned on schedule since CDOT will need to review TIP project applications for which its support or funding contribution is requested as well as its own applications.

3. Other DRCOG Items

- Jacob and DRCOG staff provided updates on other DRCOG activities, including the Active Transportation Plan, the current call for TDM projects, the VTCLI (Veterans Transportation Community Living Initiative) project, and other activities. There was group discussion about holding a coordination meeting for the UPWP mid-year review.

4. Federal MPO Performance Targets

- Beth Doliboa gave an update on current activities regarding FAST Act performance targets (e.g., DRCOG adopted the 2018 safety targets in January and is currently working with CDOT on joint PHED and non-SOV targets.
- Matthew Helfant gave an update on the status of the Planning MOA between DRCOG, CDOT, and RTD. The draft MOA is undergoing final review and must be signed by mid-May.

5. CDOT-Region 1 and 4 updates

- Danny noted interchange 1601s for the Jefferson Parkway have been approved. There was also discussion about how many more corridor/project studies can/will be undertaken in the region.

6. RTD/transit updates

- Chris Quinn said that RTD is not granting any more requests for service buy-ups because of the ongoing driver shortage. He also gave updates on other RTD activities, including the Pass Program Work Group's recommendations.

7. FHWA/FTA updates

- Bill Hass noted that CDOT's draft STIP will be adopted in June, and that FHWA completed its annual risk assessment, which he will present at the next ACT meeting.
- Kristin said FTA is processing two grants for RTD that need to be aligned in the TIP and STIP. One grant relates to the FasTracks Southeast Extension, and the other grant relates to operations and shelters.

- South Coast Court Decision Discussion-
 - Tim Russ suggested that to be proactive, DRCOG and NFRMPO should include reference to the 1997 MVEBs in their ozone conformity documents. He did not anticipate any issues for DRCOG or NFRMPO in their current conformity cycles, but will monitor the case and talk with HQ.
- DRCOG updates
 - Jacob Riger updated the ICG on the 2017 Amendments to the 2040 MVRTP.
- NFRMPO updates
 - Becky Karasko updated the ICG on the NFRMPO's model being updated and the plan to move to an annual TIP. She also confirmed that new air quality modeling will not need to be done for their updated plan, as the projects stay within the current staging years.
- RAQC updates
 - Amanda Brimmer gave an update on the EPA attainment/nonattainment designations for the 2015 ozone standard, anticipated by April 30.
- CDOT Updates
 - Rose Waldman described her efforts to update CDOT's air quality guidance document and will seek review from the MPOs as well as EPA and OTAQ.
- EPA Updates
 - Tim Russ told the group that the 2017 revisions to Regulation 10 are almost signed by the RA as well as the Moderate Ozone rule, which will begin an open comment period.
- APCD Updates
 - Rick Coffin described the updates to the DERA program, including funding opportunities for diesel trucks in the upcoming call for projects. Additionally, the work APCD has done on exceptional events from wildfires in 2017 is near completion and will be open to public comment in the near future.
