1. DRCOG 2045 MVRTP

- Jacob Riger noted that the 2017 amendment cycle for the 2040 MVRTP would open later this summer/fall, with Board adoption in early 2018.
- CDOT staff discussed several potential amendments, including I-25 South widening. CDOT is beginning to assess the revenue and budget implications of SB-267.

2. DRCOG TIP

- 2018-2021 TIP: Todd Cottrell noted a couple potential administrative amendments. Larry Squires raised the issue of how projects on the rollover list are portrayed in the TIP and STIP; the group discussed this issue further.
- 2020-2023 TIP: Todd and Doug Rex summarized current activities of the TIP Policy Work
 Group. There was discussion on the optimal timing of CDOT's "4P" county hearings vis-à-vis
 the anticipated timing of the TIP calls for projects in early- and mid-2018.

3. UPWP

2018-2019 UPWP: Todd noted that the UPWP was adopted by the DRCOG Board at its July
 19, 2017 meeting.

4. Other DRCOG Items

 Jacob and DRCOG staff provided updates on other DRCOG activities, including the Active Transportation Plan (in contract negotiation), preliminary work on FAST Act safety target setting, and other activities.

5. CDOT-Region 1 and 4 updates

- o Both regions touched on the status of current projects and NEPA/PEL studies.
- Region 1 noted several requests for 1601 interchange approvals on far east I-70. CDOT will be fronting a \$600,000 study using RPP funds to coordinate the various requests re: interchange spacing, roadway alignments, etc.
- Region 4 noted the possible advancement of Segments 5 and 6 of North I-25 depending on SB-267 revenues.

6. RTD/transit updates

 Susan and Larry discussed the ongoing 16th Street Mall redesign project; there is an open house the next day. There was discussion about at what point in the study DRCOG staff should be involved.

7. FHWA/FTA updates

o Larry noted that FTA can't process grants with an old TIP listing.

Dale Wells, APCDDRCOG updates

Steve Cook updated the ICG on the schedule for the upcoming 2040 and 2045 MVRTP.

NFRMPO updates

- Becky Karasko discussed the NFRMPO's upcoming amendment schedule, including North I-25 segments 5&6. If the schedules work out, DRCOG and NFRMPO will attempt to bring both amendments to AQCC together in the winter/spring of 2018.
- NFRMPO and DRCOG both established that we will use 2020, 2030, and 2040 as our staging years, beginning with the next amendment cycle.

RAQC updates

Amanda Brimmer gave an update the 2017 ozone season. At the time, it appeared that the region may meet the current budget in the 2017 ozone season. However, Amanda asked whether Tim Russ or Abby Fulton understood the current process for a redesignation to a 'Serious' non-attainment area or if a 179B exemption may be possible. Neither Tim nor Abby had a concrete response at this time, but they suggested they will follow up as soon as any news because available.
