## 2. Informational Briefings

### *Can Do Colorado eBike Pilot Program*

Christian Williss, from Colorado Energy Office (CEO), provided an overview of their Can Do Colorado eBike Pilot Program. The pilot is part of the statewide Can Do Colorado Community Challenge, an initiative that aims to support local communities and businesses during the COVID-19 pandemic. The eBike program is designed to demonstrate that e-bikes are a safe, healthy and convenient way to take essential trips. The program is a partnership between the CEO, Bicycle Colorado and Northeast Transportation Connections. The eBike pilot is an ownership-based model, where qualifying individuals are gifted with an e-bike and accessories to replace trips otherwise taken by a car. Program participants were selected based on: transportation need, employment status, annual income, occupation and essential worker status, location, agreement with program rules and other benefits that may impact a participants quality of life. The Fall mini-pilot, currently underway with 13 participants, runs through December 31, 2020. An at-scale pilot will be rolled out across Colorado in spring of 2021.

### *RTD's Emerging MaaS Strategy*

Brian Welch, Senior Manager of Planning Technical Services at RTD, provided an overview of RTD's emerging MaaS strategy and introduced new pilot programs/partnerships. Mr. Welch provided the group with an overview of the mobility as a service (MaaS) concept and outlined RTD's perspective of MaaS as it relates to RTD's core mission and services. Mr. Welch highlighted the integration of travel information, booking and payment and RTD's work on integrating travel information (trip planning, price info) and booking/payment (single trip, book and pay).

Mr. Welch and RTD staff provided overview for several projects/programs including the Kyyti app for intermodal trip planning and FlexRide booking, FlexRide-Metro Taxi integration in DRC, payment integration (Lyft, Kyyti and Masabi), Uber partnership and other MaaS potential projects.

## 3. Partner Agency Updates

Ms. Lindsey provided the group with several updates including: the upcoming Metro Vision Idea Exchange,<sup>1</sup> the next AMP WG meeting focus on data and an upcoming E-mobility Equity Conference.<sup>2</sup> Ms. Nysten provided the group with an update on the upcoming FCC vote regarding a split of the 5.9 GHz band for wi-fi uses.<sup>3</sup>
