Chair Shaw called the meeting to order at 5:45 p.m. with a guorum present.

# Move to Adopt the Consent Agenda

Director Levy moved to adopt the consent agenda. The motion was seconded and passed unanimously.

Items on the consent agenda included:

Minutes of the August 18, 2021 Meeting

Discussion of a resolution authorizing the Executive Director to accept funds of \$80,000 from the City of Aurora to support transportation services for its older adult residents. Sharon Day provided a brief explanation of the funds to the committee. The Aurora City Council approved an annual allocation of \$80,000 for transportation services in 2017 that benefit older adult residents of Aurora. In 2018, DRCOG and the City of Aurora entered into an agreement in which DRCOG would receive the \$80,000 to launch a pilot transportation program. The pilot initially involved subcontracting with Seniors' Resource Center (SRC) to facilitate trips more for personal purposes versus medical and grocery purposes. The pilot ended in 2019 when the funds were fully expended and later, SRC ended its transportation program. The City recently approached DRCOG once again to allocate another \$80,000 for the same purpose. If accepted, the \$80,000 will be paid in a lump sum to be used in DRCOG's voucher transportation program.

Director Levy **moved** to adopt Resolution No. 18, 2021, authorizing the Executive Director to accept funds of \$80,000 from the City of Aurora to support transportation services for its older adult residents. The motion was **seconded** and **passed** unanimously.

Finance and Budget Committee Meeting Summary September 15, 2021 Page 2

<u>Discussion of a resolution authorizing the Executive Director to distribute approximately</u> \$580,000 in 2022 NSIP funds to contracted nutrition providers.

Sharon Day, provided a brief overview of the fund distributions to the committee. Through the State Unit on Aging, NSIP funds are awarded to DRCOG and other Area Agencies on Aging in proportion to the number of OAA meals served throughout the state in the previous year. FFY2021 NSIP is based on FFY2019 counts instead of FFY2020 or FFY2021 because of the COVID-19 pandemic. The amount allocated to the DRCOG AAA shall be distributed to Volunteers of America (VOA) and Project AngelHeart. Neither DRCOG nor the State are aware of the exact number of dollars DRCOG will receive, however DRCOG anticipates receiving approximately \$580,000.

Director Dale **moved** to adopt <u>Resolution No. 19, 2021,</u> authorizing the Executive Director to distribute approximately \$580,000 in 2022 NSIP funds to contracted nutrition providers. The motion was **seconded** and **passed** unanimously.

# Report of Executive Director

ED Rex wanted to inform members of the committee that DRCOG staff are conducting a salary compensation survey that is performed every five years. ED Rex and DRCOG Division Directors will evaluate the results of that of that survey. If there is a need to increase salaries based on these findings, a budget amendment maybe needed.

# **SUMMARY**

The Articles of Association state that "The Nominating Committee shall be appointed in November of each year and consist of member representatives herein designated: The Immediate Past Chair of the Board (or the Vice Chair if there is no Immediate Past Chair); one Board member representing the City and County of Denver; one member selected by the Finance and Budget Committee ...; one member selected by the Performance & Engagement Committee ...; one member selected by the Board; and one member selected by the Board Chair." If more than one member expresses interest in serving, a ballot vote will be taken to select the Nominating Committee member.

At the January meeting each year, the Nominating Committee shall present to the Board nominations for Executive Committee members to be elected at the February meeting.

The Board has established the following guidelines to assist in selection of members of the Nominating Committee:

- Members of the Nominating Committee are not eligible to be nominated for a position on the Executive Committee (Board Officer) by the committee or from the floor.
- Members of the Nominating Committee shall have served not less than one year on the Board before being eligible to serve on the Nominating Committee.
- A designated alternate may not serve on the Nominating Committee.
- In the appointment of the Nominating Committee, consideration shall be given to providing representation of a broad cross-section of the Board, taking into account community size, geographic location, the rate of growth, county and municipality, rural and suburban and other factors.

#### SUMMARY

The Administration for Community Living (ACL) is the federal oversight agency for Older Americans Act monies. The ACL has allocated funds to the states for the purpose of helping older adults and their caregivers obtain COVID-19 vaccinations. The grant was issued to Colorado's State Unit on Aging (SUA), which was directed to distribute the funds to the Area Agencies on Aging for purposes of disseminating credible information about COVID-19 vaccines, arranging or providing accessible transportation to COVID-19 vaccination sites, assisting with reminders for individuals' second vaccination appointment, and related support.

DRCOG is allocated approximately \$315K in a cost reimbursement contract with the SUA. Activities planned may include targeted outreach to communities with lower vaccination rates, education surrounding booster shots, and funding transportation to vaccination sites. The funds are available for approximately one year starting October 15, 2021 through September 30, 2022.
