RE: Douglas County Forum Priority Projects for CDOT's 4P Update

On behalf of the Douglas Forum Transportation, there was a consensus among the Technical Working Group (TWG) and Steering Committee Members on providing the following list of priority projects as part of CDOT's current Project Priority Programming Process (4P).

Our Forum specifically focused our attention on identifying projects which we believe should be CDOT's highest priorities over the next four (4) years and are referred as "4 yr. priority" while the other priorities listed below are for the out years (5 thru 10). Generally, we did not include important CDOT maintenance projects, except for the Happy Canyon Road over I-25 Bridge Replacement Project, which ideally should occur while the local agency advance improving / reconstructing the I-25 / Happy Canyon Interchange which is estimated to begin in 2026.

- Lone Tree Mobility Hub – 4 yr. priority
- Castle Rock Mobility Hub – 4 yr. priority
- Complete US 85 (SH 67 to Daniels Park Road) per 2002 ROD – 4 yr. priority
- Complete US 85 (Daniels Park Road to Meadows) per 2002 ROD – 4 yr. priority
- Accelerate US 85 Bike/Ped commitments per 2002 ROD – 4 yr. priority
- Accelerate SH 83 Bike/Ped infrastructure between Parker and Franktown – 4 yr. priority
- Accelerate SH 83 Safety and Traffic Operational Improvements (from Bayou Gulch Road to El Paso County / Palmer Divide Road) – 4 yr. priority
- I-25 / Lincoln Mobility Project (Construction in 2026/2027) – 4 yr. priority
- I-25 / Crystal Valley Interchange (Construction in 2024/2025) – 4 yr. priority
- C-470 Trail Grade Separated Crossing at Broadway – 4 yr. priority
- I-25 / Happy Canyon Interchange (Bridge Replacement Project) in partnership with local agencies plans to improve the interchange (Construction in 2026/2027) – 4 yr. priority
- SH 86 Corridor PEL Study (I-25 in Castle Rock to Elizabeth in Elbert County)
