Background Ozone

- EPA recognizes background ozone as a significant issue, especially in West
- Background ozone is ozone arising from natural events and non-U.S.
 anthropogenic sources
- Past studies have shown 60-80% of high ozone in NFR and Colorado due to background ozone
- EPA is developing a white paper on background ozone and will hold a workshop in coming months
- EPA is revising its Exceptional Events
 Rule to provide guidance for exceptional events demonstrations
- EPA offers provisions of CAA section 179B to address impact of non-U.S. sources on local areas
