Action Item: At today’s meeting, the Steering Committee needs to vote to approve either (a) the TWG’s recommendations as presented in the attachment or (b) make modifications to the TWG’s recommendation as determined collectively by this Steering Committee. Note, only one person can vote from each of the following agencies: Castle Pines, Castle Rock, Douglas County, Larkspur, Littleton, Lone Tree, and Parker. Votes can be made by an elected official or designated representative present at today’s virtual meeting.

The Technical Working Group (TWG) Project Selection Subcommittee reviewed and scored the various Douglas County subregional project applications and met on **February 16, 2023**, to discuss and make project funding recommendations for the Steering Committee to review and finalize at today’s meeting. This includes allocating funds for **AQ/MM track** and allocating funds for the **STBG track**, as well as approval of the project waiting list priorities.

Project funding recommendations and wait list priorities are due to DRCOG on or before **March 15th**.

Enclosed is an Excel spreadsheet for the Steering Committee to review. Prior to this Steering Committee meeting, please work with your agency’s TWG representatives to discuss the project applications, the TWG selection process and the TWG’s project funding recommendations as well as the Waiting List priorities. Six funding options were considered by the TWG.

In the attached spreadsheet, we have provided to the Steering Committee with the TWG funding recommendations in addition to the DRCOG standard method of allocating funding based solely on scoring. The TWG funding recommendations are summarized below.

I-25 and Crystal Valley Pkwy Interchange - **\$8.500 M** (initial request \$9.0 M)

Castle Pines

I-25 and Happy Canyon Interchange – preconstruction - **\$2.238 M** (initial request \$3.0 M)

Parker

SH 83 and Main Street Roadway Operation - preconstruction - **\$500 K** (initial request \$500 K)
