Call #4 Overview and Q/A Josh Schwenk (DRCOG) (25 minutes)

Call #4 (Subregional) opens **November 28th** and **\$192.3 M** is available for the DRCOG MPO. DC Forum is estimated to be allocated **10.37%** of available funds, which is currently **\$19.945 M**. This includes **\$11.238 M** in **STBG** funds and **\$8.707 M** in **AQ/MMOF** funds.

Call #4 Waiting List – Projects not selected for funding will be added to a Subregional Wait List

Ask DRCOG to give a “ball park” - best guess of amount available to Wait List Projects

Call #4 Applications - Individual projects should be submitted using **1** of the following tracks:

- **AQ/MMOF Track** (Majority of AQ/MMOF funds are in 2026 and 2027)
- **STGB Track** (STBG funds are distributed over 2024, 2025, 2026 and 2027)

Individual transit, bike and / or pedestrian projects can be submitted using either track

Confirm there is no limit on number of projects each agency can submit in **Call #4**

Confirm that TWG wants to have DRCOG staff score **Call #4** projects (DRCOG has agreed to review up to 15 applications from each Subregion)

Develop Strategies for Call #4 Projects (45 minutes)

Develop Call #4 list of potential projects to present to Steering Committee on **12/7/2022** and share the following information before or at the November 17th TWG Meeting:

- Name of Project, estimated project costs, estimated ask from DRCOG funds, and which Track (AQ/MMOF or STBG) will you most likely use to submit a project.
