# Call 4 Subregional Process Schedule

Feb 6: Forums score, discuss, recommend list of projects

Feb 6-24: Eligible Applications Posted by DRCOG for Public Comment

Early March TBD: TSC/SRF meetings

March 15: Send DRCOG list of recommended projects, wait list

March/April: Call 4 recommendations to TAC, RTC and Board

July 19: Draft TIP FY 2024-227 Public Hearing

July/August: New TIP recommendations and adoption

Late August: TIP call 3-4 award notification, IGA process begins

# Call 4 DRCOG Considerations

- Call 4: programming of projects for FY2024-27
- \$46,584,000 million available to program in Call 4 (STBG: \$26,247,000M, AQ/MM \$20,337,000M)
- Funds available at different times/coordination with project schedules
- CMAQ/MMOF requirements (question for DRCOG)

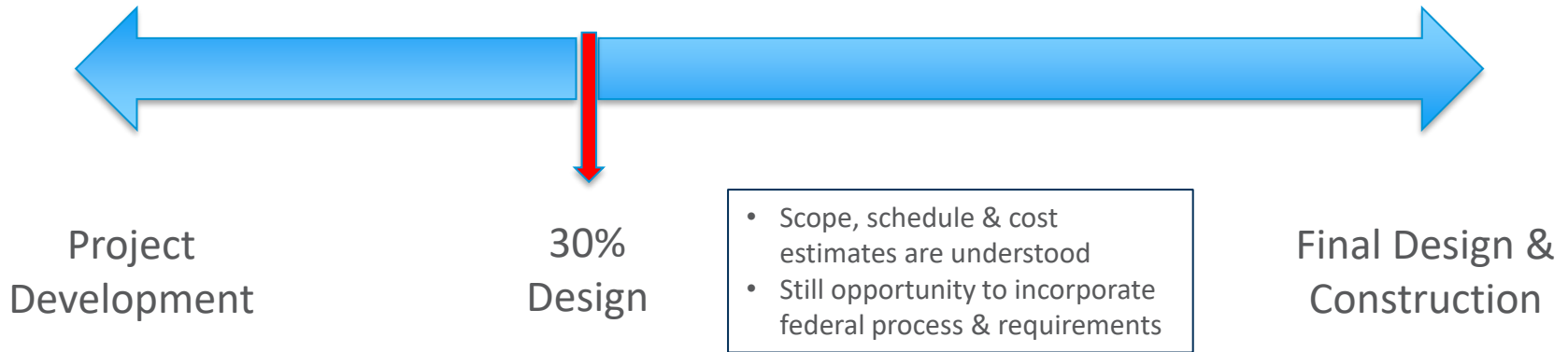
# Call #4: DOTI considerations

- Try to federalize fewer projects, but support more projects overall by reprogramming local (Denver) dollars
- Fund projects at the right project development stage
- Attempt to find both design & construction opportunities
- Using federal funds adds time & cost to a project, so be selective



# Call 4: DOTI considerations

- Federalization: What's the 'best' stage of project lifecycle to federalize for TIP?



# Project identification process summary

- Call for projects
- Is/could this project be federalized?
- If for construction, is there enough design to inform cost, scope & schedule – but not so far along it would challenge project to add federal dollars
- Can project meet funding requirements and/or be low risk for DRCOG project delays
