Project Description:

The Sanderson Gulch Resiliency Project addresses flooding, multimodal trail improvements and the preservation of a crucial bridge in southwest Denver. Improvements include the construction of a realigned trail along the Sanderson Gulch corridor, the lowering of the creek, replacement of culverts under the roadways, and nature-based creek improvements.

Total Project Cost: \$8.4 (PROTECT eligible); \$20M total project

PROTECT Grant Funding Request: \$4.2M
