Call to Order

Chair Bob Davis called the meeting to order at 12:15pm.

<u>Visiting Nurse Association</u> – Tara Fitzgerald provided a presentation on the services provided by Visiting Nurse Association. Discussion was had.

Emergency Preparedness Denver CERT – Carolyn Bluhm provided a presentation on Emergency Preparedness and Denver's Community Emergency Response Team (CERT). Discussion was had.

<u>Approval of the October 17, 2014 meeting summary</u> – Sharon Perea MOVED to accept the summary with amendments Muriel Arvay SECONDED. The summary was accepted as written.

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Funding Subcommittee Report — Steve Watson discussed the distribution of funds for Visually Impaired Services. There were 5 proposals to provide services. The Committee funded 3 of the proposals submitted. The American Council of the Blind and Visually Impaired of Colorado (ACBCO) received \$132,968, the Center for People with Disabilities (CPWD) received \$44,556, and Seniors' Resource Center (SRC) received \$37,993. Motion was made to accept the funding subcommittees report. A motion was made, ACCEPTED and SECONDED and passed UNANIMOUSLY on the report. Hendrik Kopperl advised the committee that the report has received board approval but asked the committee to keep information confidential.

Motion to cancel the December meeting - Bob Davis made a motion to cancel Decembers ACA meeting. Tex Elam motioned to ACCEPT canceling the December meeting Janet Romarine SECONDED. Motion passed UNANIMOUSLY.

Public Comment - No public comment was given.

<u>Director's Report</u> – Jayla advised the committee that she and Sarah Stevens, from Senator Bennett's office visited Seniors' Resource Center, to tour the Adult Day Care Center, Chore Services operation, and their transportation center.

The RFP was released for the fiscal management part of the Veterans Directed Community and Home Based Benefit Program.

<u>Legislative Update</u> – Rich updated the committee that the Governor included \$4 million for the State Fund for Senior Services (SFSS) in his budget. There may be legislation to move the \$4 million to the Older Coloradoans Fund. Rich and other advocates for older adults are trying to establish a Blue Ribbon Commission of high level experts in a variety of fields to evaluate the impact of the aging of the population on all sectors of society. The Commission will develop a comprehensive, strategic plan and make recommendations for implementation.
