Committee Responsibilities:

- Intended to be the primary policy committee of DRCOG
- Provides recommendations to the Board for action on Metro Vision issues, plans and implementation

Process Highlights

- MVIC will consider draft plan elements and through consensus direct staff to make revisions
- Detailed summaries of MVIC discussion will be provided to the Board

etro Vision

- MVIC recommendations will be "bundled" for Board consideration and action
- When all draft elements have been accepted the Board will release a public review draft

Process Highlights Other Items of Note

- Prior to MVIC the full Board will be notified of the upcoming meeting
 - Including details of issues that will be discussed
