- ◆ MVIC should get in the weeds and when ready forward bundles of items to the full Board
- ◆ Board should give MVIC "permission"



MVIC Committee Description

As Revised March 2014

Committee Responsibilities:

- ◆ Intended to be the primary policy committee of DRCOG
- ◆ Provides recommendations to the Board for action on Metro Vision issues, plans and implementation



Process Highlights

- ◆ **MVIC will consider draft plan elements and through consensus direct staff to make revisions**
- ◆ **Detailed summaries of MVIC discussion will be provided to the Board**
- ◆ **MVIC recommendations will be “bundled” for Board consideration and action**
- ◆ **When all draft elements have been accepted the Board will release a public review draft**

- ◆ **Prior to MVIC the full Board will be notified of the upcoming meeting**
 - Including details of issues that will be discussed
- ◆ **All Board members and alternates are invited to attend MVIC and participate in the discussion**
