






## Countywide Project Evaluation

### ♦ Intent:

- Is to provide an opportunity to fund countywide priorities, while still
  maintaining the policy focus of supporting centers and the corridors that serve
  them and reinforcing regional priorities
- A forum established within each county
  - Make-up: County and local staff (recommendations must go to appropriate elected body)
  - Establish evaluation criteria, but must follow PSRC's policy framework (e.g. support of centers and corridors that serve them)
- <u>Broadens</u> the definition of centers to include locally designated centers identified by the countywide planning process
- Funds can be used on any federal functionally classified roadway

# Regional Project Evaluation

- Intent:
  - ◆ To select a limited number of regional, high-priority projects
- ◆ Number of Applications = 36
  - ◆ 6 each from Kitsap, Pierce and Snohomish Counties
  - ◆ 12 from King County
  - ◆ 2 each from WSDOT, Sound Transit, Puget Sound Clean Air
- Categories of projects
  - Regional Growth Centers
  - Manufacturing/Industrial Centers
  - Corridors serving Centers
