- <u>Active Transportation Infrastructure Investment Program</u>
 - \$44.5 million to support projects that create comprehensive networks of bicycle and pedestrian pathways.
 - Applications due June 17.
- Multimodal Project Discretionary Grant Program (MPDG)
 - \$1.7 billion for National Infrastructure Project Assistance (Mega).
 - \$2.7 billion for Infrastructure for Rebuilding America (INFRA).
 - \$780 million for Rural Surface Transportation Grant (<u>Rural</u>).
 - Applications due May 6.
