



  - Proxy for return on investment (ROI)
  - Expenditures: DRCOG funds (2008-2019)
    - Historical (2008-2011)
    - Programmed (2012-2015)
    - First Phase Projects from new TIP (2016-2019)
  - Contributions:
    - Population
    - Employment
    - VMT
    - State HUTF Disbursement to Counties



- TIP Score
  - From First Phase
- Multi-Jurisdictional Projects
  - Cross the geographic boundary of two or more DRCOG jurisdictions
  - Funding partners?
- Projects not eligible in First Phase
  - Studies and Other Enhancement Projects



- Number of Sponsor Projects Selected in First Phase
  - Also note: amount of funds awarded and total number of projects submitted by the sponsor
- First-Last Mile Connection



- Expands quality of access to transit
- Must be safe, intuitive and universally accessible

## First-Last Mile Connection

<u>Bike</u> (bike path, multi-use path) and/or <u>Pedestrian</u> <u>projects</u> that physically touch transit property or stop or eliminate a barrier that impedes patrons from accessing transit (Bicycle/Pedestrian projects)

Roadway projects that include bike (bike path, multiuse path) and/or pedestrian facilities that physically touch transit property or stop or eliminate a barrier that impedes patrons from accessing transit (Roadway Capacity, Roadway Operational Improvement and Roadway Reconstruction projects)

<u>Shuttle/Circulator projects</u> that services transit (Transit Service projects)

 Projects must provide a connection to a destination (residential development, school, office, shopping, dining, park, recreational facility) or fill a gap connecting to a destination within a one mile buffer from a transit property
