**ARVADA RESIDENT BOB WILSON HONORED BY DRCOG**

**April 28, 2014 (Denver, Colorado)** – Arvada resident Robert (Bob) E. Wilson received a Distinguished Service Award from the Denver Regional Council of Governments (DRCOG). The award was presented by Douglas County Commissioner and DRCOG Chair Jack Hilbert at the regional council's 2014 Awards Event, held April 23 at the History Colorado Center.

The award recognizes Wilson's service on DRCOG's Citizens Advisory Committee, which is focused on involving residents to develop a new regional plan for the metro area, known as Metro Vision 2040.
