Toll Gate Creek Trail (ongoing): The northern portion of the Toll Gate Creek Trail adjacent to Fitzsimons Parkway from Montview Boulevard north through Sand Creek Park (2700 N. Peoria St.) is closed to accommodate construction of the Aurora commuter rail line/Interstate 225 project. Pedestrians and cyclists should use the sidewalks along Colfax Avenue and Peoria Street as a detour. Please use caution and observe all trail closures through Sand Creek Park. High Line Canal Trail (intermittent): The High Line Canal at Second and Abilene will have periodic closures near the credit union building due to I-225 rail line construction. Please use caution when traveling in this area.

The spring runoff and daily storms have increased water flow levels in Clear Creek. Due to recent flooding and remaining sediment, a section of the Clear Creek Trail of trail under the 44th Avenue bridge (between Kipling and Wadsworth) will be closed. Please be aware other sections of the Clear Creek Trail in Wheat Ridge also have standing water and debris on the trail surface, but remain passable.

Cyclists are encouraged to check the Wheat Ridge website, use caution and be aware of changing conditions while riding the Clear Creek Trail in Wheat Ridge.

Main Street (Ken Pratt Boulevard to Third Avenue): Due to construction, bicyclists should consider alternative routes via Fourth Avenue or Ken Pratt Boulevard (sidewalks) to Martin Street or South Pratt Parkway.

Coal Creek Trail: Temporarily closed at the airport taxiway culvert south of Vista Parkway due to elevated water levels (primarily caused by spring runoff). Pedestrians and bicyclists who approach from either the north or south will see trail closure signs and must turn around at the closure. Pay close attention to barricades and signage, and do not cross over the airport taxiway. The parks and recreation department will inspect conditions daily and provide an update when the trail is fully open.
