# Updates

- The *Decarbonize DRCOG* grant was officially submitted to the EPA on **April 1st!**
  - Award of funds announced in **July 2024**
  - If awarded, funds received in **October 2024**

# CPRG Budget

<b>Central Program Administration*</b>	<b>\$32,478,705</b>	<b>16.3%</b>
<b>Measure 1: LIDAC Decarbonization</b>	<b>\$48,106,435</b>	<b>24.1%</b>
<b>Measure 2: Energy Advising</b>	<b>\$17,463,443</b>	<b>8.7%</b>
<b>Measure 3: Rebates and Incentives</b>	<b>\$43,063,443</b>	<b>21.6%</b>
<b>Measure 4: Policy Collaborative</b>	<b>\$39,209,385</b>	<b>19.6%</b>
<b>Workforce and Industry Development</b>	<b>\$19,384,385</b>	<b>9.7%</b>
<b>Total CPRG Funds</b>	<b>\$199,705,797</b>	<b>100%</b>

# Climate Pollution Reduction Planning Grant Requirements

- The planning grant funds are designated for the completion of the following products:

1. Priority Climate Action Plan (PCAP)

Due March 1, 2024

2. **Comprehensive Climate Action Plan (CCAP)**

**Due August 1, 2025**

3. Status Report

Due August 1, 2027

# Comprehensive Climate Action Plan Elements

- **GHG inventory**
- GHG emissions projections
- GHG Reduction Targets
- Quantified GHG Reduction Measures
- **Benefits Analysis (co-pollutants)**
- LIDAC Benefits Analysis
- Review of Authority to Implement
- Intersection with other funding availability
- **Workforce Planning Analysis**
- Next Steps/Future Budget & Staffing

\*Bolded words are completed by way of the PCAP.
