Climate Pollution Reduction Planner starts on Aug 16



- Interviewing three consultant teams this week
 - Consultant anticipated to start work on Sept 1



- EPA plans to release NOFO for \$4.6b in implementation grants in September.
- Priority Climate Action Plan is due March 1, 2024
 - Quantified GHG measures must be included in the plan to be eligible for implementation grants

POTENTIAL UPCOMING STAKEHOLDER SCHEDULE



- Sept 5 Identify methodologies and priorities for consultant
- Oct 3 Sector-specific measures
- Nov 7 Sector-specific measures
- Dec 5 Sector-specific measures
- Jan 2 Final decisions regarding components/measures in plan
- Feb 6 Final review of draft Priority Climate Action Plan

PRIORITY CLIMATE ACTION PLAN KEY ELEMENTS



- GHG Inventory
- Quantified GHG Measures
- Low-Income and Disadvantaged Communities Benefits Analysis
- Authority to Implement

WHAT WE KNOW ABOUT IMPLEMENTATION GRANTS



- Measures must be identified and quantified in PCAP
 - Source Categories / Activities Affected
 - Estimated Reductions / Uncertainty
 - Criteria Pollutant Co-benefits
 - Toxic Air Pollutant Co-benefits
 - Benefits in Nonattainment Areas
 - Benefits analysis for LIDAC
 - Authority to implement
