PROJECT STATUS – WORK BEGINS



- Lotus Engineering and Sustainability selected as consultant
 - SOW anticipated to be finalized this week 
- Maddy Nesbit joins team as CPRG Planner
- EPA plans to release NOFO for \$4.6b in implementation grants in mid- September
 - Grants to be based off PCAP, not CCAP 
 - Grant applications due April 1st 2024
- Priority Climate Action Plan is due March 1, 2024
 - Quantified GHG measures must be included in the plan to be eligible for implementation grants
 - Five stakeholder meetings left

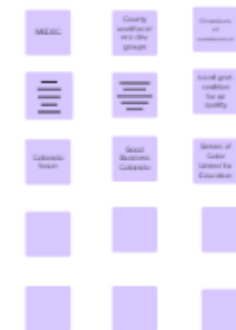
