Fiscal year 2023-2024 budget

Background: DRCOG's budget is the fiscal guide for its operation. The

budget, prepared by DRCOG staff, highlights work plan activities for the Denver metropolitan area. Each year, DRCOG's Finance and Budget Committee and Board of Directors review and consider the budget for the next fiscal year, in this case, July 1, 2023, through June 30, 2024. The Finance and Budget Committee reviewed the thendraft fiscal year 2023-2024 budget on April 5 at a special meeting and April 19 at its standing meeting, ultimately recommending it for Board approval.

Result: The Board approved the fiscal year 2023-2024 Budget and Work Program.

Background: In late November 2022, DRCOG issued the final of four calls for projects that together will program \$455 million in available funds from federal fiscal year 2022 through 2027. When the subregional share call closed on Jan. 27, 84 applications had been submitted requesting a total of \$307.8 million for \$193.2 million in funding available. For the subregional share process, DRCOG staff provided each forum with a funding target based on average subregional population, employment and estimated vehicle miles traveled as a share

of the regional total. Each subregional forum developed a recommended slate of projects within its funding target and a waiting list. DRCOG solicited public comment on the forums' slates of projects. It received 1,073 comments, which it provided to forums to consider in their funding recommendation deliberations.

The project recommendations for calls No. 3 (approved in November 2022) and No. 4 will be included in the draft fiscal years 2024-2027 Transportation Improvement Program currently anticipated to be considered by the Board in August 2023.

Result: The Board approved the recommended subregional share projects to be included in the draft fiscal years 2024-2027 Transportation Improvement Program.

<u>Update on status of Regional</u> <u>Transportation District FasTracks</u> <u>projects</u>
