Project Scope

Project widens Smoky Hill Rd to include an eleven foot westbound right-turn lane; an acceleration lane from the Safeway driveway about 550 feet east of the Himalaya St intersection; and a deceleration lane from Himalaya St to Gibraltar St. Sidewalk widening to eight feet, landscaping between sidewalk, pedestrian refuge areas in median, and retaining wall are also included. Signal modifications to the northbound approach will also be provided. Project installs lighting at Smoky Hill Rd and Gibraltar St and Himalaya St and the Safeway access, multi-modal information kiosk at the bus shelter, bike racks, and a data collection camera for traffic counts. The widening to accommodate the acceleration/deceleration lanes would occur in the existing wide median to minimize retaining wall and right of way impacts.



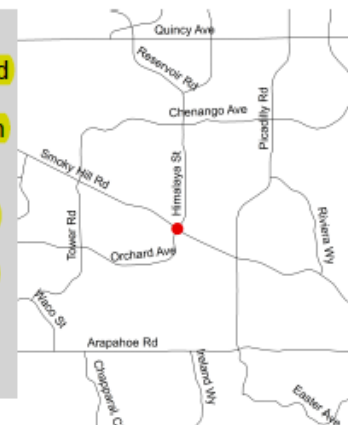

Project Scope

Project restripes the Smoky Hill Rd/Himalaya St Intersection to add a westbound right-turn lane beginning at the Safeway gas station, add a second westbound left-turn lane, add a second northbound left-turn lane, modify existing median on Orchard Rd approach, add a raised center median on the west leg with a pedestrian refuge, and widened sidewalks to eight-feet, except from the Safeway gas station drive to the main Safeway plaza drive, east of Himalaya St along Smoky Hill Rd. Project will also include traffic signal modifications, pedestrian lighting at the three signalized intersections, multi-modal information kiosks at two bus shelters, bike racks, and video detection infrastructure.
